

Champagnes and Sparkling Wine

1. Bouvet Saphir Vintage Brut, Méthode traditionnelle **£25.00**

Pale gold with amber tints, crystal clear fine bubbles. Full bodied with long lasting aromas of white flowers, peach, acacia, honey and hazelnut. Well balanced with a fresh style.

2. Bouvet Brut Rose Excellence, Méthode traditionnelle **£25.50**

Salmon pink and partridge eye colour with a ripe-berry bouquet with redcurrant and long lasting aromas of raspberry, strawberry and fine herbal piquancy. Plenty of fruit and lingering finish.

6. Ponte Treviso Prosecco, Extra Dry **£25.00**

Light yellow in colour with greenish reflections. Delicately fruity with reminiscence of apple, pear, citrus fruits and floral hints on the nose. It has a lively and light taste.

7. Ponte Aurora Rose Prosecco, Spumante Extra Dry **£25.50**

Rose with violet reflections in colour with a fresh bouquet and a scent of small red fruits. It has a well-balanced taste and excellent as an aperitif and with light food.

3. Mercier Brut (House Champagne) **£40.00**

Mercier, based in the Epernay region of France and is the number one selling brand of Champagne in the domestic French market. A paleyellow colour, with a delightfully fresh finish.

5. Mercier, Brut Rose (House Champagne) **£45.00**

An assemblage of pinot Noir and Meunier, Mercier Brut Rose is initially distinguished by its beautiful pink colour and coppery glimmers. The bouquet is redolent of wild berries from the forest.

4. Tattinger, Brut Reserve **£55.00**

From Champagne's oldest cellars, this Champagne has peach and acacia notes on the nose, a citrus-fresh yet delicately honeyed palate, and a beautiful, elegant finish.

8. Tattinger, Brut Prestige Rose **£70.00**

An intense cherry-pink in color with extremely fine, Its classic, aromatic Pinot fragrance of red raspberries and strawberries is offset by elegant, subtle floral and earth nuances into a crisp, refreshing finish.

9. Cristal Louis Roederer, 2005 **£190.00**

With a core of lush ripe fruit and toasted hazelnuts on the finish, 2005 Cristal is one of the most flamboyant Cristal Champagnes.

White

10. Sauvignon Blanc Pays d'Oc, La Place, SW France **£18.50**

Vibrant and zesty with the classic sauvignon nose of gooseberries and a hint of tropical fruit on the light bodied, crisp unoaked palate

11. Chardonnay, Franschoek Cellar, S. Africa **£18.50**

Pure and bright pineapple, lemon and lime on the nose and palate with a perky balancing acidity to the frisky finish, unoaked.

Rose

42. Clos Du Canalet, Pays d'Oc France **£18.50**

Rich red fruit aromas of raspberries and red cherries. Ripe cherries on the palate with great concentration. An excellent finish and perfect rose for all occasions!

Red

26. Merlot Pays d'Oc, La Place, SW France **£18.50**

Soft and elegant with ripe damson fruit character, subtle tannin and a long elegant finish

27. Cabernet Sauvignon, Franschoek Cellar, S. Africa **£18.50**

Deep red crimson in colour with intense blackcurrants and violets on the nose providing a suitable introduction to concentrated currants and mulberry fruit flavours. The flavours of the cabernet Sauvignon are elaborated by attractive savoury oak spice to a smooth and lingering fruit finish.

White Wines

France - Loire

12. Muscadet, Château de la Galissonniere **£21.00**

Sèvre et Maine sur lie, produced with the white grape Melon de Bourgogne which is synonymous with the Muscadet appellation in the western Loire Valley. A show of apple and citrus flavours, with mineral characteristics

14. Vouvray, Domaine de Vaufray **£22.50**

The wine gives a sweet sensation with a dry finish on the palate. A concentration of rich flavors develop fruity aromas such as fresh grapes and ripe quinces with slight honey notes.

15. Sancerre "Clos des Bouffants" Roger Neveu **£28.00**

Aromas of ripe rhubarb and gooseberry leap from the pale lemon coloured glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint. Mineral texture, high acidity, vibrant green fruits and a long, lingering finish. Best enjoyed as a partner to goats cheese torte, tomato salads, with freshly caught seafood or glazed ham.

16. Bordeaux, Moelleux, dessert wine **£19.50**

Sweet but not over the edge

France - Burgundy

17. Chablis, Domaine Alain Gautheron **£28.00**

Floral aromas, apple fruit and complex, rich mineral character derived from the subtle influence of the chalky vineyard soil, Fermentation and maturation is in vat to preserve the fresh steely flavors and lively balanced citrus finish. A good aperitif and complement to oysters, shellfish grilled fish and cheeses.

18. Chablis 1^{er} Cru, Les Vaudevey, Domaine Laroche **£36.50**

Clear, bright limpid yellow color with lots of mineral aromas over a layer of lemon peel. This is a nervy, racy, and lively wine

19. Macon Lugny, Louis Latour **£26.00**

Pale gold in colour, with a beguiling aroma of fresh apples, lemon curd and toasted citrus fruits atop a palate of fresh and crisp green-apple acidity, buttery and peachy fruit and a long, warming finish.



South Africa

20. Cleefs Classic Collection, Chenin Blanc

£23.00

Strong lychee, citrusy and guava aromas on the nose with ripe pineapple and peach flavours that follow through on the palate. A fresh and fruity style of Chenin Blanc with a long clean and crisp finish.

Italy

21. Pinot Grigio, Ponte

£21.75

From the Veneto region of Italy and is a light straw yellow colour with greenish reflections, light and fruity, dry with a good structure. Ideal with risotto, pasta and light cheeses.

New Zealand

22. Momo, Marlborough, Sauvignon Blanc

£27.50

An enticing nose of nettles, lime, trademark gooseberry notes as well as some apple blossom, the wine bursts with vibrancy in the mouth showcasing lovely green fruits – lime, kiwi, passionfruit along with a liberal dash of citrus. Really zippy acidity, almost with a touch of fizz that makes your mouth water and a very decent length of flavor.

Australia

23. Tempus Two Semillon Sauvignon

£25.00

The Semillon provides texture, bringing subtle apple and citrus characters while the Sauvignon Blanc adds gooseberry and tropical notes. A fresh, clean, crisp wine with natural fruit sweetness and a zesty acidity giving great structure and balance. On the palate fresh, clean, crisp style with luscious gooseberry, apple and citrus flavours. Fruit sweetness and zesty acidity give this wine great structure and balance. On the nose, fresh citrus, lemons and limes combined with gooseberry and herbal characters from the Sauvignon Blanc.

Chile

24. Sauvignon Blanc, Classic Series, Montes

£22.50

A crispy and fruity wine. Light yellow-green colour; bright and clear. The aroma shows pure and intense character.

25. Chardonnay, Marques de Cas, Concha y Toro

£28.50

Light yellow in colour combining richness with elegance and vibrancy. This ripe and delicious wine offers flavourful aromas of white pear, toasted hazelnut and mineral notes. Deeply concentrated.

Rosé Wines

France

43. Côtes de Provence Rosé, Sables d'Azur **£21.00**

Sables d'Azur blends of the best selection of Rosé wines from interior Valley of Provence and Sainte Victoire Terroir and is a pale peach coloured rose. An elegant nose with delicate hints of small red fruits (red currant) and sweet citrus fruits (clementine, sweet grapefruit). Crispy and fresh mouth with a good balance between alcohol and acidity.

Australia

45. Rose, McGuigan Black Label **£18.50**

packed with zesty cherry and strawberry fruit flavours. Together with great length and a clean, smooth finish. On the nose its bursting with fresh, lively cherry and strawberry Perfect for summer drinking as an accompaniment to fish, chicken and light red meat dishes.

Italy

46. Pinot Grigio Rose, Blush, Lamberti **£21.95**

A dry, fresh and fruity rose with delicate aromas of red berries. Soft and creamy textured - with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit, and a vibrant finish. Serve as an aperitif or to accompany salads, cold meats such as salami or smoked chicken or seafood dishes.

Red Wines

Italy

28. Chianti, Collezione, Sensi **£22.50**

Good colour. Sour cherry, earth and blueberries on the nose. Palate of strawberries, cherries, earth almond. In the nose this is a bit spicy and the taste is a bit tart but full of red cherries, light chianti body with a lingering taste.

29. Barolo, Rivetto Del Comune Di Serralunga D'alba, **£48.00**

Is one of the world greatest wines, age in oak with Violet and Rose Aroma and fruity full bodied flavor.

Spain

30. Marques De Caceras, Rioja Crianza **£25.00**

Dark ruby red color. Fresh notes of red berries on the nose enriched by a depth of vanilla and sweet spice. Clean and lively on tasting with ripe tannins that blend with balanced structure. Fleshy in the mouth with delicious flavors. A perfect accompaniment to fried food, rice dishes, pasta, fish in tomato sauce, ham, chorizo, pate and beef.

31. Cune Reserva, Rioja **£32.00**

Rich, deep aromas of bramble, red autumn fruit with a hint of balsamic and warm spices from fine oak.

Portugal

32. Esteva Casa Ferreirinha, **£25.00**

Ruby-coloured wine with an intense and harmonious bouquet, rich in ripe red berries, floral notes and oaky aromas (cedar and cigar box). A soft attack on the palate reveals a fine structure with well-integrated tannins, red berries and a hint of pepper. The wine's acidity is well integrated and an elegant finish.

South Africa

33. Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot, **£28.00**

This "Red Estate" Buitenverwachting is full of ripe berry flavours Intermingled with hints of mineral and cigar box characters which make the wine well structured.

California

34. Zinfandel Red, Beyer Ranch, Wente **£27.50**

It is well-balanced on the palate with good acidity and delicious toasty oak.

Chile

42. Syrah, Marques de Casa, Concha y Toro **£28.50**

Spice, jammy fruit and a rich silky finish. This Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault and Mourvèdre blend exemplifies all that is great about the increasingly-popular Southern Rhône reds.



France – Bordeaux

35. Château Roc De Bernon, Puisseguin St Emilion £27.00

Boasting a beautiful deep garnet color, this wine offers clear and bright intense and delicate nose of red fruits, with floral notes.

36. Château Haut-Beau séjour, Saint Estèphe £36.00

This is a modern, polished wine, solidly packed with dark tannins and dense fruits.

Argentina

37. Malbec Mendoza, Bodega Terrazas de los Andes £30.00

Intense purplish colour with red shades. Very expressive, revealing a floral and red fruit profile of violet, raspberry and cherry, with marked aromas of toasted coffee and chocolate. Characterised by a broad and sweet mouthfeel, delicate tannins add finesse

France - Burgundy

38. Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Laforet, Joseph Drouhin £28.50

On the palate, the wine is pleasant, fruity and refreshing, with light tannins and great elegance.

39. Nuits Saint Georges, Domaine des Clos £40.00

The fresh and densely fruited dark berry nose is quite ripe with an Intensely earthy and sauvage character.

Côtes du Rhône

40. Côtes du Rhône, Domaine St Gayan Controlee £25.00

Spice, jammy fruit and a rich silky finish. This Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault and Mourvèdre blend exemplifies all that is great about the increasingly-popular Southern Rhône reds.

41. Châteauneuf du Pape "Clos Du Mont Olivet £36.00

Loaded with dark cherry, leather, mineral, liquorice and roasted herbs, this medium-bodied, seamless and nicely concentrated and has a great texture, solid mid-palate depth and sweet tannin.
